




Fig. 2 • Transfer Characteristics




Fig. 3 • Capacitance




Fig. 4 • On-Resistance Variation with Temperature




Fig. 5 • Gate Threshold Variation with Temperature

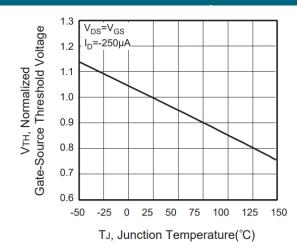



Fig. 6 • Body Diode Forward Voltage Variation with Source Current




Fig. 8 • Maximum Safe Operating Area





Fig. 9 • Switching Test Circuit

Fig. 10 • Switching Waveforms








Fig. 11 - Normalized Thermal Transient Impedance Curve



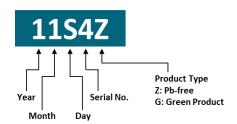

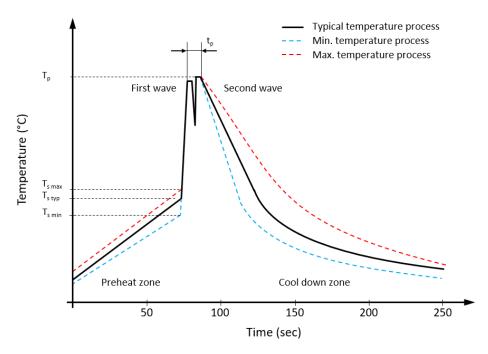
